Road Rules: Israel

Objective:

Get your team around Israel in the least amount of time, and have the most money left at the end of the game.

Points:

Your team can earn up to 100 by completing the task at each destination. Your team can earn additional money by completing the bonus task. Your team can also earn additional money during the two bonus rounds. Your team can only use money that you have when deciding to travel from place to place.

Warning: Your team might lose time depending on how your team chooses to travel (and time is important!).

Rules:

When we begin, each team will receive an envelope with their first destination. When you arrive at your destination you will find a Staff member with instructions for your task. Each team will have 5 minutes to complete their challenge (and bonus where they exist). Then they will have 2 minutes to choose how to travel to their next destination (based on what mode of transportation the group can afford) and then get to your next destination before the next round begins.

Jerusalem (Old City):

In Jerusalem, there are people that will sell you a red string to wear around your wrist. Some believe that this string keeps away the evil eye (eyen ha'rah). You must find the hidden red strings hidden in the Kotel.

Bonus: After you find the red string, find the missing item from each newspaper puzzle. Win an extra 10 25 per solved puzzle.

Dead Sea: Conversions

Welcome to the Dead Sea. As you take a float, match the answers on the ground to the posters on the wall (You must try to figure out the American conversion for Israeli weather, weight, distance, etc.). With each correct match your team will receive <u>D</u> 20.

Tel Aviv: Coupon Match

In the middle of the mall you will find a fountain filled with "water". Inside are many coupons for many stores. Your group needs to find a coupon for each of the available stores in the mall (and correctly match the coupon to the right store). Only one coupon may be taken from the fountain at a time. With each correct match your team will receive <u>10</u> 10. Points off for littering!

Eilat: Scuba

Welcome to Eilat. I hope you brought your S.C.U.B.A. gear because you're going diving for coins! Your challenge here is to fish out the following *exact* amounts. In this challenge you may only have one hand in the water at a time and when your hand comes out of the water you must dump you change on to the "sand." Once the change is on the sand you can only add coins until you have exact change. If you pull out American coins, or more than the amount that you are searching for, all the coins will go back into the water and you will have to start over.

Find exactly: □ 2.40 /□ 5.25 /□ 11.10

<u>Bonus</u>: Each person without looking can reach in and grab one coin. Add the total number of shkalim fished out to your team's sum of money.

Be'er Sheva: Taste test

Enjoy a taste of Israeli snacks and drinks and try to match correctly what you are tasting to the menu. Only one taste per person. Each person that correctly identifies a flavor will receive 1 shekel for his or her team.

Bonus: Make a jingle for one of the products for <u>□ 25</u>

Tiberias: CD Store

Listen to the CD and match the track with the picutes on the wall of the artist or the CD cover. <u>n 25</u> per correct match.

Bonus: Make a list of songs in Hebrew. Each song will earn your team <u>15</u>

Golan: Resturant

Put the puzzle together to find out your instructions.

Enjoy a round of Jeopardy and win the corresponding \square amount for each question answered correctly.

Massada: Double Down the Mountain

Have the entire team stand on an open newspaper page for $\underline{n} \underline{25}$. Then fold the page in half and double the amount to $\underline{n} \underline{50}$. Keep doubling for as long as you can.

Kibbutz Keturah: Herzl Omar / Yam Yobasha

Try your skills at two classic Israeli childhood games. Start with Herzl Omar and play for two minutes. After two minutes each player still in the game will receive <u>D</u> 25. Then do the same for the next game.

BONUS BONUS BONUS

Doar: Alphabetize (everyone)

Each group will receive 20 addressed envelope and will need to put them in "alef-bet"-ical order. 50 shekels for the first team, 40, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 1, 1

Super Sol: Price is right (everyone)

This station is the last chance for groups to earn money. One member from each group will be called down and will receive points for each correct bid (the closest amount without going over).
